Introducing the MPN Alliance Australia (MPN AA)

The Myeloproliferative Neoplasm Alliance Australia (MPN AA) was formed in 2015 by a small group of motivated patients who themselves had a diagnosis of MPN. The patient-led advocacy group **collaborates with the Leukaemia Foundation of Australia** with the common goal of achieving better outcomes for Australian MPN patients.

We aim to increase awareness and understanding of the MPNs and the plight of patients living with these rare diseases.

Unifying the Australian MPN community by sharing quality, up-to-date information and vital links to existing resources, organisations and support, will be beneficial to newly diagnosed and existing patients and their families.

MPN patient quality of life is central to everything we do. Together, we strive to advocate for access to emerging treatments as well as contribute toward research to aid in the search for a cure.

The MPN AA and the Leukaemia Foundation have collaborated to establish a dedicated fund.
